Reminders

- Students aged 12-18 who are deemed at risk can now receive the Pfizer vaccine at Bangkok Metropolitan Administration affiliated schools. Further details at <https://tinyurl.com/4y32bpyw>
- If you are having trouble registering for a Covid-19 vaccination please contact the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MFA) at foreignvac@gmail.com. If you successfully registered for a vaccine via the MFA website but have received an email stating your application has been declined, call the MFA on +66 (0) 2572 8442
- The Ministry of Public Health have launched a 'Digital Health Pass' for those that are either fully vaccinated or had a negative covid-19 test result. It can be used to assist with domestic travel and to obtain access, when needed, to services from shops and other venues. Access is by Mor Prom which can be download as follows:

- NHS COVID Passes/Vaccine Passports are currently not available for people who have been vaccinated outside of the UK
- The CCSA has confirmed that foreigners in Thailand should not contact their Embassy to register for a vaccine

Vaccine Registration

- Foreign residents over the age of 18 can register for their first vaccine at <https://expatvac.consular.go.th/>. You can also register for a vaccine appointment at any hospital where you have prior medical records or at hospitals that offer vaccines for purchase
- Principal Health Care have opened a Moderna covid-19 vaccination registration for those aged 12 and above. Vaccinations available from January 2022 at PRINC hospitals across the country. Further details at <https://vaccineregister.princhealth.com/>
- British people who are at least 60 years old with one of 7 stated chronic illnesses and all employees of British Chamber of Commerce Thailand member companies operating in dark red zones can register interest to receive a vaccine at <https://tinyurl.com/yy2e4tuf>

Bangkok



- If you are over the age of 40, have any of the 7 underlying health conditions or are 12+ weeks pregnant you can pre-register for a vaccine at Vimut hospital
- Bangpakok 9 International Hospital and Piyavej Hospital are open for Sinopharm registration. Further details (in Thai) at <https://bpkconnect.com/ecommerce/sinopharm>
- MedPark Hospital have opened registration for Moderna vaccines for children aged 12 – 17. Details at <https://www.medparkhospital.com> or via LINE @medpark.thailand
- Reservations for the Moderna Alternative COVID-19 vaccine can be made at a number of hospitals including Bumrungrad, Chaophaya, Viphavadi and Sirirat Piya Maharaj Karoon

Buriram

If you have a pink ID card you can register via the MorProm app or your local hospital. If you do not have a pink ID card, register with your local hospital.

- If you are over the age of 40, living with any of the 7 underlying health conditions or 12+ weeks pregnant you can pre-register. Hospitals include Samithivej Sriracha and Bangkok Pattaya

Hua Hin

KamphaengPhet

Register for a vaccine at any public hospital. Your employer may also be able to register on your behalf. For more information, contact Khampangphet provincial public health office vaccine hotline, on 093 111 8593.

Khon Kaen

- Register via your district's main public hospital or at Srinagarind Khon Kaen hospital, Regional Health Promotion Centre 7 and Khon Kaen hospital
- If you live in Khon Kaen and are over the age of 40, have one of the 7 underlying health conditions or 12+ weeks pregnant you can pre-register at Bangkok-Khon Kaen Hospital at http://it-nurse.bkn.co.th/index_vaccine.php

Lamphun

If you are aged 12 or older, you can register for a Pfizer vaccine by calling 091-486-8266. The vaccination will be administered at Lamphun Hospital.

Phitsanoluk

- Please complete a pre-registration of alternative COVID-19 vaccine (Moderna) at <https://vaccineregister.princhealth.com/>
- The vaccination will be available at Pitsanuvej hospital from early 2022

Phuket

Ubon Ratchathani

- If you live in Ubon Ratchathani you can register for a vaccine by taking your passport to the Vaccine Registration Centre at Ubon Ratchathani Provincial Health Office
